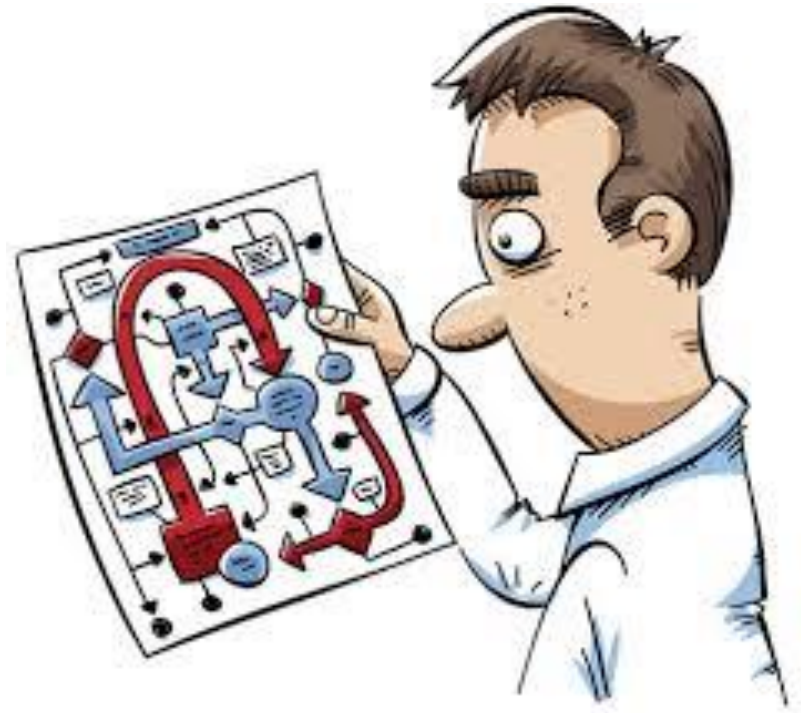
Resource Challenges

- Tools to discover insight from data



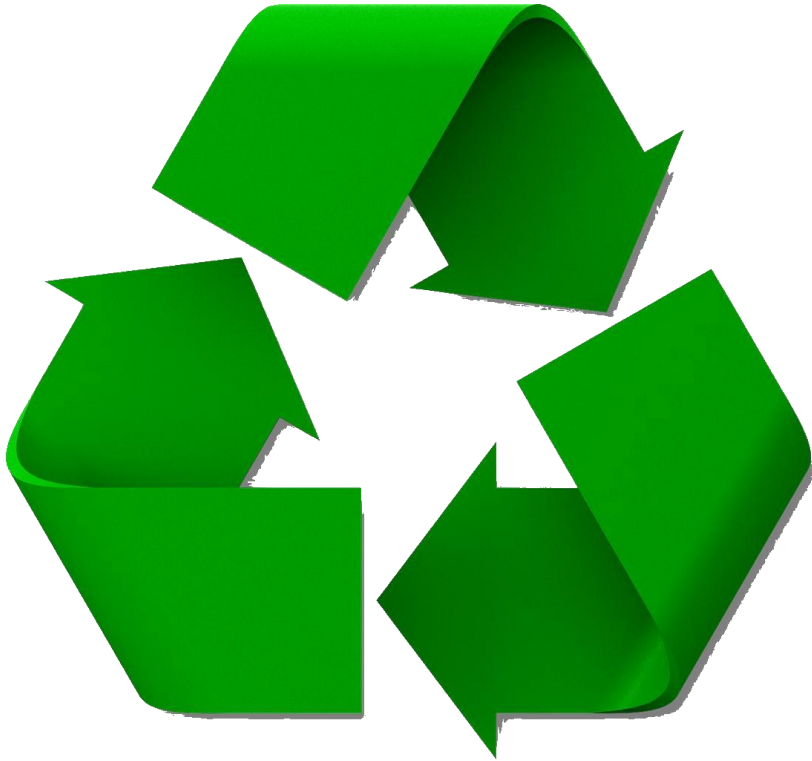
Operational Advantages

- Shared footprint much smaller than sum of individual

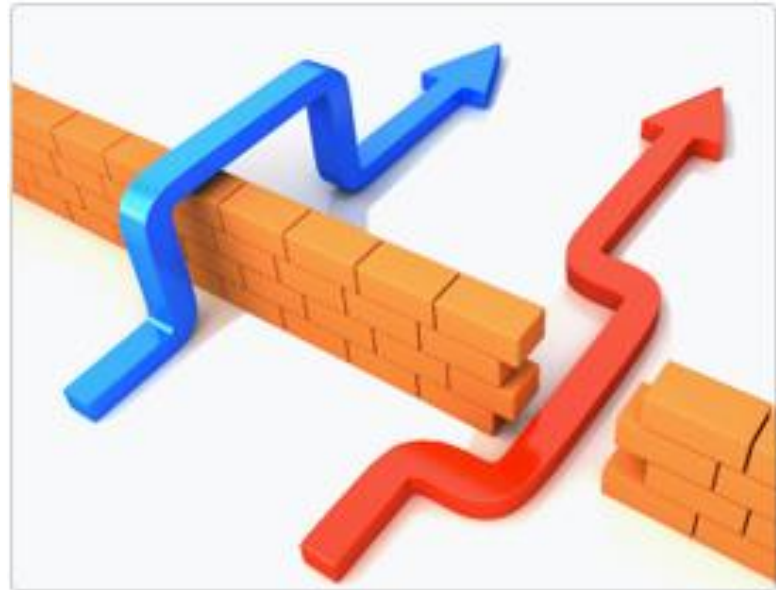
Agility Concerns...



- “Lack of data integration inhibits innovation/insight”
- “Resistance in IT organizations to make data fully accessible and leverage-able”
- Data in a locked box is counter productive”
- “How do you get the data out?”
- “What do you do with it?”

Agility, Acceleration

- Low barrier to entry
- Drives exploration, experimentation, and discovery
- Elasticity



Agility, Acceleration



- Flexibility

Security Concerns...



- Data security concerns? Target?

ROI Concerns...
